



Nieves Guri

(Mallorca, 1984) is an artist and psychologist (Escola Massana, Barcelona, 2014; University of the Balearic Islands, 2010) whose practice focuses on composition and the minimalist use of matter. Her work is characterized by the use of black tones on untreated materials and, more broadly, by an affinity for materials, textures, and supports such as handmade papers and inks crafted manually from endemic plants. Recurrent symbolic references to traditional crafts and Balearic heritage appear throughout her work.

Her textile practice often reflects on mutability and adaptation to change. Through a meticulous and intimate process, she seeks to contrast a social reality marked by haste, exhaustion, and cultural uprooting.

She has taken part in group exhibitions such as Art Nit Campos (2025), Porus, Art per al Canvi (2024, Studio Weil, curated by Aina Pomar Cloquell), Territori tèxtil (Museu de Porreres, 2024), and Observatori (Son Tugores, 2024), both curated by Tomeu Simonet. In 2025, she participates in Swab Art Fair (Barcelona) represented by **a66Gallery**, and receives the Acquisition Award from the Bassat Foundation. That same year, she presents her solo exhibition Aether at Can Gelabert (Mallorca), curated by Asun Clar. Her work has been selected in competitions such as the XV Certamen d'Arts Plàstiques d'Inca and the Certamen d'Arts Plàstiques i Visuals Vila de Binissalem 2024. She has received distinctions including the Lab Oliver Award 2024 (Menorca) for the audiovisual project Tot Això Serà la Terra, and the Lab Oliver Award 2023 for Taula, which also received recognition in the Exhibition Projects Call of the Casa de Cultura de El Campello (Alicante, 2024).

She has undertaken creative residencies at La Gascona (Cuenca, 2025), Sa Talaia (Mallorca, 2024 and 2023), Casa d'Artistes (Menorca, 2022, 2023), and El Limbo (Cabo de Gata, Almería, 2022), in collaboration with artist Ernesto Artillo. In the performing arts, she received the La Teta Premium (Mallorca, 2023) for the performance Cualquiera, developed with the collective Nadie, of which she is a member. She performed in Lo Incondicional (2022, Ernesto Artillo, Teatros del Canal, Madrid) and created the visual scenography for Miss CCCP (Ksenia Guinea), presented at the Festival de Otoño de la Comunidad de Madrid (Teatro Réplika).

Statement

“My artistic process is guided by compositional and material decisions rooted in social, philosophical, psychological, and political concerns. Slow, reconstructive processes—along with the use of natural materials and techniques, and the pursuit of organic textures and forms—serve as a counterpoint

to the cultural and traditional uprooting of our times, offering instead a contemplative gaze upon our surroundings and an exaltation of their simplicity.

References to traditional crafts and to emblematic elements of the Balearic natural environment—such as the mastic tree (*Lentiscus*) and stone, both with a rich history of cultural and symbolic meaning—carry for me a significance tied to sustainability, transformation, and therefore, hope.

The discourse on transformation and the possibilities generated by change does not end with the production of the work; it continues into the exhibition phase, where the pieces adapt to the site-specific context, allowing their appearance to evolve according to the space.”

“Many of the artist’s works are open to the air. They are offered, hanging, at the mercy of the movement that may animate them, and among the seams of textile fragments that compose – like a collage– the large fabrics, emptiness seeps in, reminding us that nothing is compact, that what we see is just the union of minimal and invisible particles.” – Asun Clar (Art Curator)

“Caring for the land through rootedness in the environment is part of Mallorcan artist Nieves Guri’s practice. To produce her works, she often uses handmade and recycled papers, organic fabrics, and also creates her own inks from leaves of the Balearic shrub mata (Pistacia lentiscus).” – Aina Pomar Cloquell (Art Curator)
