Statement – Painting the Virtual Mind

„My continuing experimentation in contemporizing the classical theme of the realistic nude in landscape, is leading me increasingly toward confrontation with our contemporary concept of realism itself. Photography permanently changed the visual vocabulary of realism in painting at the beginning of the 20th century.

The development of digital image processing and the rise of virtual reality have not only expanded our visual vocabulary further but have permanently altered our mental cognition of the boundaries of realism.

It fascinates me to explore the limits of realism in painting while maintaining a dialogue with the masters of figuration in art history.

I work in a completely analog painting technique, just like the masters of the past, while articulating reality through the eyes of a contemporary virtual reality influenced mind. I have decided that, in order to contemporize the painted nude in landscape, I will have to let go of the last vestiges of idyllic fantasies which linger in my mind and fully embrace the synthetic reality of contemporary existence.

I suspect that my struggle with this process reflects every man's struggle with this process and THAT is in fact the true subject of my new work.“
